



Bursary Conditions

1. Fund4Trees (F4T) is able to offer bursaries of up to £500. Please consult the website for deadlines (www.fund4trees.org.uk).
2. Funds are provided to individuals to assist with subsistence and travel costs for trips home or abroad specifically designed to enhance their arboricultural knowledge.
3. The F4T bursaries exclude group expeditions or participation in tours or courses organised by other bodies or commercial enterprises.
4. Successful candidates must submit a comprehensive written report of no less than 2,000 words to Fund4Trees within three months of the agreed completion date. This could be used by Fund4Trees for publication in a range of arboricultural trade magazines. Candidates may be invited to present their findings at future arboricultural events.
5. Eligible applications will be assessed by members of the Fund4Trees Research Advisory Committee (RAC) and on the merits of the proposed project potential to the arboricultural and forestry profession and the ability to deliver against the Fund4Trees objectives. Awards will be subject to references: see the Bursary application form.
6. Candidates will be advised within 4-6 weeks of the submission deadline and the Fund4Trees RAC decision is final.
7. If successful, Candidates will need to accept the offer formally by either letter or email within 14 days of the award.
8. Fund4Trees is unable to assist in seeking any remaining funds required for the project. If a Candidate is unable to obtain the total funds required to carry out their project then F4T reserves the right to withdraw the Bursary offer. There is some flexibility on project timings to ensure that the bursaries are used.
